Artist in Focus: Gabriele Münter

Who can enter? Foundation to Year 6 students learning German in AGTV member schools

What do students from **Foundation to Year 6** need to do?

1. **Produce an artwork** inspired by artworks of Gabriele Münter.
2. **Give the artwork a title in German.**
3. **Write a brief artist's statement** in English or German on how the artist inspired your artwork.

NB: Additional task required from students in Years 3 to 6

4. **Write an *Elfchen* or *Akrostisches Gedicht* in German** related to the artist or your artwork.

Entries: Schools select **TWO entries per year level** for state final judging.

Entries are photographed and saved as a jpg to submit with the school entry form.

Entry forms will be posted on the AGTV website under 'Noticeboard'.

Deadline for receipt of entries: Friday, 7th September 2018 or earlier

About Gabriele Münter (1877 - 1962)

Gabriele Münter was a photographer and Expressionist painter and founding member of *Der blaue Reiter* group. Münter painted landscapes, streetscapes, portraits, still life and more in a distinctive style developed initially under the influence of Wassily Kandinsky.
