Our activities were:

- February PD We had a team of 6 presenters and a total of 39 participants. 19 evaluations were received. This event is very popular at the start of each year.
- VCE at the PD Buffet in May at Scotch College. The VCE team conducted this event alongside the popular Middle Years Program and had a small number of participants (approximately 12). It was a very successful day for those who attended the workshops.
- A senior practice exam was produced for sale through the Goethe Boutique.
- A Year 12 Student Forum was held at University High School in August. More than 100 students and teachers attended representing 27 schools and 9 networks. The event was a huge success.
