Advertising Guidelines

The Committee cannot presume what members will or will not be interested in. However, not all advertising received will be forwarded. Decisions will be informed by these guidelines.

Child Safe Environment

Children's safety will be a consideration in all matters related to children including recommendations of events, resources, courses and other services for students under 18.

Emails to members

From time to time, the Committee may forward information from reputable commercial and not-for-profit organisations which may be of interest to teachers or students of German. This may include notices about relevant resources, events, professional development, language courses, scholarships and other opportunities to support the teaching and learning of German.

Individual members will be forwarded notices about opportunities for employment.

AGTV Website

The Committee will provide links to commercial enterprises and not-for-profit organisations in relation to matters relating to the teaching and learning of German including ideas for excursions.

Teachers' Journal SZENE

The Committee will charge for advertising products and services in SZENE and distinguish between commercial and not-for-profit organisations. The Committee reserve the right to waive charges e.g. the Goethe-Institut provides funding to support SZENE, so is not charged for advertising.

Professional Development Programs

The Committee may invite booksellers or other service providers to exhibit or present at professional development events. The Committee will determine if a registration fee is required on a case by case basis. The Committee has the discretion to waive or reduce fees.

Victorian State Conference

Exhibitors at the Victorian State Conference will be required to pay an exhibitor fee to be physically present at the conference. Distinctions will be made between commercial and not-for-profit organisations.

The Committee will invite organisations to supply material for the conference folder for a fee for service to pack the items in the folder and provide to delegates.

Scholarships, Exchange Programs and Courses

The AGTV currently offers its own AGTV-BJR exchange program, sponsors a scholarship through the SAGSE program, and supports the Goethe-Institut/AGTV Year 10 Awards. These opportunities will be actively promoted by the AGTV.

Other scholarships and courses for teachers and students of German may also be promoted including those from Goethe-Institut Australia and Kultur und Sprache in Austria.
